- Tuesday, April 24, U.S. Representative Dennis Kucinich entered a resolution into Congress to impeach Vice President Cheney. Now three representatives are officially calling for Cheney's impeachment.

- Wednesday, April 25, 50 prominent voices of conscience stood up in front of the U.S. Capitol to demand the impeachment of President George W. Bush and Vice President Dick Cheney.

- Tuesday, May 1, at 6pm, Bush announced his veto of the Supplemental Appropriations Bill, sending a message that he is determined to continue the unjust war on Iraq, no matter what you think. Protests were held across the country Wednesday, May 2nd.
